The Historic Environment Record

The Clwyd-Powys Historic Environment Record (HER) is currently only available in English. A programme has been initiated to translate the record into Welsh, over the coming years using a staged approach. As the first stage, the framework (introductory text, site navigation bars etc) of *Archwilio* has been translated into Welsh. This will progress with the translation of the data glossaries and eventually develop to cover the entire record. The Welsh Archaeological Trusts aspire to adopt a Welsh Language Policy.
